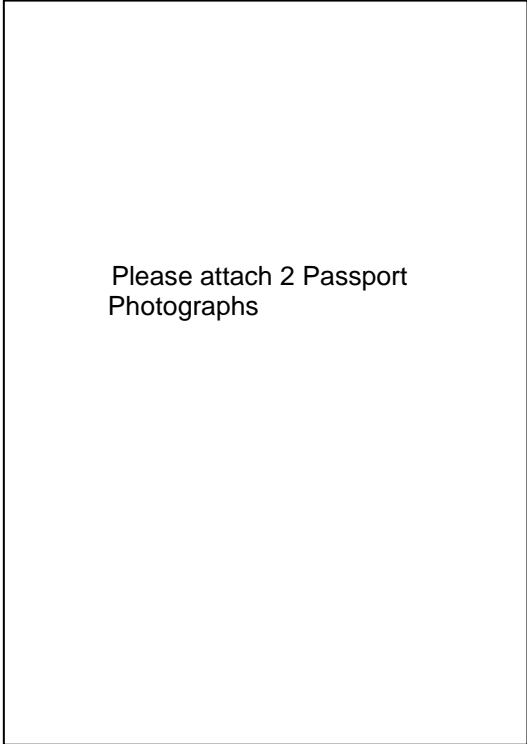

1. The FAW Safeguarding Scheme Card is issued to you as a demonstration of your compliance with the FAW DBS programme. It is not an identity card and should not be used for this purpose.
2. On the front of the FAW Safeguarding Scheme Card, the following details will be displayed:-
 - Your name (as it appears in our database)
 - The date on which a DBS was issued
 - The Area Association in which you were participating at the time of the check
 - A photograph of you reproduced from a photograph provided by you (the hardcopy will be held on file by the FAW)
 - Expiry date for the Safeguarding Scheme Card
3. As a holder of an FAW Safeguarding Scheme Card, you do not have any additional rights of access to grounds or changing rooms or any other environment which you would not normally have access to.
4. You will be provided with a lanyard and a rigid plastic holder. You have been provided with these to assist you in displaying the Safeguarding Scheme Card as stated below.
5. When in a footballing environment where children are present, you shall openly display your Safeguarding Scheme Card at all times.
6. If you are subject to action relating to a Safeguarding issue, the FAW may choose to remove your FAW Safeguarding Scheme Card, either on a temporary basis or permanently, depending on the outcome.
7. You must surrender your Safeguarding Scheme Card immediately when requested to do so by the FAW.
8. If your Safeguarding Scheme Card is removed from you, the FAW will publicise your name, address and relevant Area Association to all relevant parties.
9. When requested to do so by a designated Area, League or Club Safeguarding Officer, you must produce your card for inspection. Failure to do so may result in a report to the FAW Safeguarding Team who may investigate the matter.
10. A failure to display the FAW Safeguarding Scheme Card may also be reported to the FAW Safeguarding Team.
11. A Safeguarding Scheme Card which is lost, stolen or defaced must be reported immediately to the FAW, the cost of replacing the Safeguarding Scheme Card will be borne by the cardholder. A defaced card must be returned to the FAW before a replacement will be issued.
12. A card which has passed its validity date must be returned to the FAW before a replacement will be issued.
13. All matters not specifically referred to in these terms and conditions will be referred to The Safeguarding Manager of the Football Association of Wales for a decision.

Finally, in signing this form, you are agreeing to comply with the FAW Safeguarding Policies, Practices & Procedure and the relevant Code of Conduct.
